Human Rights

Being Humans are all members in the family Hominidae* which have achieved self autonomy at one point in their life.

*Harambe Act

- 1.) **Humans have the right to be alive**, removal of this right shall not be done by any human to another, or designed* by another human to another.
 - a.) Design in this context insulates the use of other parties to commit the removal of this right.
- 2.) **Humans must be provided food to eat** with the minimal amount of nutrition* to prevent the breaking of the first human right* without violating the first human right**.
 - a.) Nutrition in this context specifically refers to caloric intake, vitamin and mineral acquisition and allergic consciousness.
 - b.) The acquisition of food must not break the first Human Right, thus killing someone for food is prohibited.
- 3.) **Humans must be provided clean water**, that does not result in the breaking of the prior two rights*. Therefore water must be received as water, not within food.
 - a.) The acquisition of water must not break the prior Human Rights, thus if the acquisition of water causes another Humans to Die this right has been violated.

- 4.) **Humans must be provided medical treatment for wounds** that would result in the violation of the prior Human Rights* and without violating the prior rights of others**.
 - a.) Violation of the Rights of the Individual being treated.
 - i.) Wounds left untreated causing death is a violation of this Right.
 - ii.) Wounds left untreated causing inability to eat is a violation of this right.
 - iii.) Wounds left untreated causing inability to drink or use water is a violation of this Right
 - b.) Violation of the Rights of Individuals not being treated.
 - i.) The acquisition of Medical equipment must not cause the death of those the equipment or procedure would have saved.
- 5.) **Humans must be provided medical treatment for illnesses** that would result in the violation of the prior Human Rights* without violating the prior rights of others**.
 - a.) Violation of the Rights of the Individual being cared for.
 - i.) Diseases left untreated or unattended that would result in death is a Violation of this Right.
 - ii.) Diseases left untreated or unattended that would result in the inability to eat is a Violation of this Right.
 - iii.) Diseases left untreated or unattended that would result in the inability to drink or use water is a violation of this Right.
 - iv.) Diseases left untreated or unattended that would result in the inability to treat wounds is a violation of this Right.
 - b.) Violation of the Rights of Individuals not being treated.
 - i.) The acquisition of Medical equipment must not cause the death of those the equipment or procedure would have saved.
- 6.) **Humans must be provided education***, either through trade** or conventional studies. This includes being able to travel to school*** without violation of the prior Rights****.
 - a.) Education must be a measurable improvement of an individual's research capability.
 - b.) Education in a trade must be a measurable improvement of an individual's marketability and proficiency.
 - c.) The duration in which it takes an individual to get to their education must not supersede the duration of the stay in the Education Class, if it does then this transportation must be provided.
 - d.) If going through Education would result in Death, Starvation, Bodily Harm, or an Illness this Right has been violated.
- 7.) **Humans have the Right to celebrate the death** of another Human through rituals that does not impose on any other Prior Rights*.
 - a.) Description of Violation of Rights in terms of Ritual Celebration.
 - i.) Celebration must not result in the Death of another Human.
 - ii.) Celebration must not cause Starvation or have the result of an inability to eat.
 - iii.) Celebration must not cause Thirst or the contamination of vital waters.
 - iv.) Celebration must not inflict bodily harm that would result in the Violation of Right Number 4.

- v.) Celebration must not spread diseases or contamination that would result in the Violation of Right Number 5.
 - vi.) Celebration must not result in the deterioration of Education.
- 8.) **Humans have the Right to travel to locations*** that do not impede on the Prior Rights of others** or result in the violation of their own Rights***.
- a.) The Right is that permission to travel must not be obstructed, but the means to which the travel is done may.
 - b.) The Individual's travel must not cause Death, Starvation, Contamination of Water, Injury, Illness, Destruction of Educational Locations or Interruption of Ritual Celebration.
 - c.) The Individual's travel must not cause their own Death, Starvation, Obstruction of their acquisition of water, Deliberate Wounding, Deliberate Illness, Deliberate Education deterioration.
 - i.) Traveling must be allowed to fulfill the Prior Rights of the Individual.
- 9.) **Humans must be provided a surrounding** that does not result in the violation of the prior rights*.
- a.) Surroundings must not cause Death, Starvation, Contamination of Water, Injury, Illness, Obstruction of Education Access, Interruption of Ritual Celebration, or the ability to travel.
 - i.) Minimal Surrounding Specifications must allow individuals to move their body freely within the center mass of the provided surrounding.
- 10.) **Humans must be allowed to communicate** to maintain mental health*. Communication does not have to be with another Human**. The Maintaining of Communication must not violate prior Rights***.
- a.) Provided Communication must not result in mental anguish.
 - b.) Provided Communication must have the stimulus of Communication.
 - c.) Communication must not Violate the Prior Human Rights in its acquisition.
- 11.) **Humans have the Right to decide what they want to do with their own body**, if this right does not impede on another Human's Human Right or their own.

Purpose of the MV Society

Article 1:

To focus Human effort towards the development of Humanity and the preservation of the planet(s) we live on. To ensure that the Human Rights are maintained and that all Humans have the ability to fulfill their passion in line with those Human Rights.

To locate, dismantle and eradicate all institutions and individuals which take advantage of Human Vulnerability for Social/Economic Growth to the detriment of the Victim's ability to pursue a fulfillment of passion in line with Human Rights.

To Build and Develop Regions to ensure that all Humans living within those borders are able to live to the full fulfillments of Rights guaranteed to them by the Human Rights.

To develop capabilities to ensure the protection of these Rights and protections for the Humans within the Regions.

Article 2:

National Identity shall be removed if the Nation/Country/State etc. are unable to guarantee the rights given to all Humans within the Human Rights.

Upon the dissolving of National Identity of the Violating Nation all Nations within the MV Society shall allow free access into their regions by those Humans who lived within the dissolved Nation.

The Highest Degree of Aggression shall be aimed to eradicate the institutions which facilitate the actions which caused the Violating Nation to Violate the Human Rights of Humans within their regions.

Universal Peace shall not be considered achieved if even one Human has their Human Rights violated by the Institutions which are to ensure that their Rights are maintained.

In the cases of Human Rights violation no violation shall be considered a Domestic Affair. The Violations of Human Rights are immediately to be under the jurisdiction of the General Body of the MV Society.

The acceptance and maintenance of the Human Rights shall be the deciding factor of membership and the breaking of those Human Rights shall be the deciding factor of removal. Governments which break Human Rights are to be dissolved. The intention to maintain Human Rights is not to be considered as a factor for membership.

Membership

Article 3:

All Regions which maintain the Human Rights shall be members of the MV Society. Violations of Human Rights are grounds for immediate removal, dissolving, and replacement of Regions which violated the Human Rights of those within the Borders. And those who facilitated the violation shall be apprehended and contained.

All Members within the MV Society shall allow all Humans to move freely within their Regions in accordance with the Human Rights, especially those which are fleeing Regions outside of the MV Society.

Member Governments must develop the Energy Capabilities of their Regions to ensure that all citizens within their Borders have both the capability and reserves to be equal to that of the base MV Society Energy Rating. Member Governments who fail to do so shall be assisted by outside regions, the refusal of this assistance then will be grounds for removal, dissolving and replacement.

All members must maintain an accurate ledger of information within their Regions. The attempt at disinformation by Member Governments shall be deemed as an effort to Violate the Human

Rights within their Regions. Information must be accurate to ensure that all of Humanity is able to develop accurately and safely.

Article 4:

No Member Nation is exempted from the repercussions of breaking Human Rights no matter their past standings. Nations/Countries/Regions etc. have fallen in the past and Humans continued to survive, the dissolving of the violating Nation will not prevent the continued development of Humanity.

Dissolved Members shall be recorded in History, all critical information from those who lived within the borders shall be recorded. Following the information acquisition the Dissolved Nation's Identifying marks shall be removed and stripped from Modern Society allowing the MV Society to use those lands to develop the Region for New Innovation and Human Growth.

Member Nations shall attempt to resolve the Issues of other Member Nations which are violating Human Rights but any attempt to withhold information from the MV Society General body shall be deemed as an effort to Violate the Humans Rights of those within Nations involved in the disinformation.

Structure

Article 5:

The MV Society shall be made of the Principal Ruler, the International Regional Advisors, the Internal Information Regional Advisors, the International Development Corps, the Internal Development Corps and the Co-Rulers.

All Individuals of these positions shall have contributed towards the Energy Capability of any Member Nation.

Individuals who have not contributed to the Energy Generation of a Region may serve as Advisors to those within the Internal Structure by are not members of it in any capacity.

Individuals within this Internal Structure must ensure the accurate representation of data is transferred to all other individuals within the Internal Structure to promote collaborations with all members.

Article 6:

No Individual within the Internal Structure shall allow Personal Affairs, Identity, Culture, or any other unique characteristics to effect their judgment. If it is discovered that this has been done then that individual is to be removed immediately.

Any Individual who attempts to block an incoming member of the Internal Structure based on anything other than false information being used to gain such a position shall be removed immediately.

The Removal of Individuals within the Internal Structure shall only result in them returning to the life of a non-internal Structure Member unless they have broken the Human Rights.

The Principal Ruler

Article 7:

Principal Rulers are to be a representation of the Enforcement of Human Rights. Meaning Principal Ruler must attribute Human Rights equally throughout all of Humanity.

All Principal Rulers must have been selected for that position by the Prior Principle Ruler. If the Principle Ruler is deemed unfit for the position by way of Violating Internal Structure Code they shall be replaced by the Co-Ruler. Upon the replacement the Co-Ruler must select a new Co-Ruler Immediately, no vacancies shall be permitted.

If the Principle Ruler is deemed unfit by the violation of Human Rights they are to be removed and disciplined appropriately as an anonymous aggressor in a random court. Then replaced by the selected Co-Ruler.

Article 8:

Principle Rulers are to oversee the direction of progress for the MV Society in terms of Energy Direction and Infrastructure.

Principle Rulers are not to make decisions on Social/Cultural Issues.

Principle Rulers decide which regions are to be removed as members from the MV Society based on the information given to them by the International Regional Advisors and the Internal Information Regional Advisors.

Principle Rulers must allocate properly to all Regions within the MV Society an equal amount of Energy and facilitate for that to be realized.

Principle Rulers are to verify information is accurate when received. The method of doing this shall be done through the allocation of orders to the International Regional Advisors.

Principle Rulers determine repercussion to those who violate Human Rights.

Article 9:

No Principle Ruler shall have an identifying unique trait that influences decision making. A violation of this is a violation of Internal Structure Code.

No Principle Ruler shall make decisions that are proven to be a violation of Human Rights even when the result would not occur a violation. Risking such a violation will be considered a violation of Internal Structure Code.

Principle Rulers shall remove any member that has violated Human Rights, not doing so will result in violation of Internal Structure Code.

Article 10:

Principle Rulers are not to allocate decision making responsibility to another individual. All decisions under the Principle Rulers time in Office shall be considered as fully under the Responsibility of the Principle Ruler.

Principle Rulers shall not willingly be misinformed or uninformed. The proven willingness shall be a Violation of Internal Structure.

International Regional Advisors

Article 11:

International Regional Advisors are the verification arm of the MV Society. The Role of the International Regional Advisor is to receive Information from the Internal Information Regional Advisors.

Individuals of the International Regional Advisor may be selected for this position by any method which ensures an Individual is qualified enough to verify data. This can be but not limited to elections, testing, personal recommendations, or promotion.

Individuals within the International Regional Advisor who are deemed unfit for this position by way of violating Internal Structure Code are to be removed and replaced. Replacement must be held in a timely manner and approved by the Principle Ruler.

Article 12:

The creation of assistance structures may be created by Individuals within the International Regional Advisor branch to facilitate the acquisition of verifying data. These new structures are

to have the International Regional Advisor act as the Sub Principle Ruler for these structures. Upon the end of duty for the Individual these structures are also to be dissolved.

International Regional Advisors may not create acts that go beyond the scope of acquiring verifying data.

International Regional Advisors may bring up an Issue to the Principle Ruler to have an order given to the Internal Information Regional Advisor so that the International Regional Advisor may verify whether correct information is given.

Article 13:

Disputes between the accuracy of data from the International Regional Advisor's acquisition and the data provided by the Internal Information Regional Advisor will be resolved either by the Internal Information Regional Advisor acquiring the data in a more accurate procedure, a secondary International Regional Advisor sent to verify, or settled by the Principle Ruler.

Acquisition of verifying Data acquired by means of violating Human Rights shall result in the International Regional Advisor's termination and subsequently disciplined appropriately as an anonymous aggressor in a random court.

Internal Information Regional Advisors

Article 14:

Internal Information Regional Advisors are the data acquisition arm of the MV Society. The primary duty of an Individual with the role of Internal Information Regional Advisor is to gather and present Information on the Region, where they are providing Energy, to the Principle Ruler.

Internal Information Regional Advisors hold similar positions to current Heads of State as when this document is written.

Internal Information Regional Advisors are to create policies within their Regions that facilitate the development of Humanity and the promotion of accurate information.

Internal Information Regional Advisors may create structures to facilitate the acquisition of accurate information.

Internal Information Regional Advisors may create structures to facilitate the development of Humanity.

Internal Information Regional Advisors are to request structural development from the Principle Ruler at which time the Principle Ruler may send the International Development Corps for trans-Regional Infrastructure or the Internal Development Corps for intra-Regional Infrastructure.

Article 15:

Internal Information Regional Advisors are to be selected by processes which result in an individual who is appropriately prepared to create fair Policies that promote Human Development, has skill to acquire accurate and timely information, and could recognize potential hazards due to outdated structural integrity or inventory discrepancies.

Policies created by an individual with the role of Internal Information Regional Advisor that result in the breaking of Human Rights are grounds for the Internal Information Regional Advisor to be removed from their Role.

At a Point where the Internal Information Regional Advisor is unable to perform their duties to accurately acquire and present information for use by the Principle Ruler they are to be removed from their Role.

An Internal Information Regional Advisor who attempts to separate from the MV Society to act as the sole Principle to create Policies in their region shall result in their Region being dissolved and their subsequent removal from their role.

Article 16:

An Individual with the Role of Internal Information Regional Advisor who breaks the Human Rights shall be removed, region dissolved and disciplined appropriately as an anonymous aggressor in a random court.

Internal Information Regional Advisors are to gather information from the entirety of the regions they cover. Focusing on one portion shall be deemed a violation of Internal Structure Code.

International Development Corps

Article 17:

The International Development Corps is a branch of the MV Society which are to Research/Develop and build infrastructure between Regions of the Society.

All Intra-Regional Structure must be done by the International Development Corps to ensure that resources and safety concerns are properly observed by the standards outlined in Internal Development Documents.

The International Development Corps must maintain an accurate record of all structures (locations, expected lifespans, functions, potential hazard, resources used) that are to be available to all members of the MV Society Structure.

The Structure of the International Development Corps must include a Principal Researcher, a Principal Developer, and Allocation Officers.

Article 18:

The International Development Corps has the duty of Constructing Resource Points to allow the fulfillment of Human Rights.

Agriculture, Medical, and Housing are Primary Constructions provided to the Internal Development Corps by the International Development Corps.

Members of the International Development Corps which violate Human Rights are to be removed and disciplined appropriately as an anonymous aggressor in a random court.

Article 19:

Resources acquisition, transportation and storage are to be done within the International Development Corps so that these resources are available for all Regions within the MV Society.

Internal Development Corps

Article 20:

The Internal Development Corps are tasked with the creation, maintaining, and acquisition of business and social structures within a region.

Individuals within the Internal Development Corps must maintain a record of damages, wear and tear of structures within the regions they are tasked with maintaining and send this information to the Principal Ruler.

The Internal Development Corps is the Branch where Individuals can request a Business Structure and License from the MV Society. The Internal Development Corps maintains the Energy allocated to the business, the records of the owners of business, and the structural safety of the Business.

The Internal Development Corps primarily receive new Projects from the Internal Information Regional Advisor.

Article 21:

Cultural Structures, Traditional Structures, Group Structures, Entertainment, and other non-Government Structures are to be developed within the Internal Development Corps.

Requests of these Non-Government Structures are to be presented to the Internal Information Regional Advisor, which would then be presented to the Principal Ruler and the Approved Order is to be worked on by the Internal Development Corp if deemed not suitable for the International Development Corps.

The Internal Development Structure must have a Principal Developer, a Social Officer, and Project Manager.

Article 22:

Members of the Internal Development Corps upon the completion of the project are to be recorded as contributing individuals to its development.

This record is to be recorded by the Internal Information Regional Advisor and given to the Principal Ruler and International Regional Advisors for updating Regional Records in the International Regional Ledger.

Co-Rulers

Article 24:

Co-Rulers are the Information Organization Branch of the MV Society.

The Primary Role of a Co-Ruler is to Store, Organize and Format Information so that it could be released to the Public.

Purposeful Filtering of Data with the intent of deception is deemed a violation of Internal Structure Code.

Article 25:

When replacing the Principal Ruler all members of the Co-Rulers must act in the role until only one remains who is most suited for the Position.

If the Principle Ruler is deemed unfit by the violation of Human Rights they are to be removed and disciplined appropriately as an anonymous aggressor in a random court. The Principal Ruler may leave this vacant if there is more than one Co-Ruler.

All Information Organized by the removed Co-Ruler must be reevaluated and compared to the raw data provided by the other branches of the MV Society by the remaining Co-Ruler(s).

The Library of Information is to be maintained by the Co-Ruler.

Acts of Aggression

Article 26:

Military-like forces are to be deployed at any instance of Human Rights Violation and dealt with quickly and swiftly using all means to do so. The Humans that are experiencing this violation of Human Rights do not have time to spar for slow actions.

No Violation of Human Rights shall be done to achieve this goal. All Aggressors are to be captured and disciplined appropriately as an anonymous aggressor in a random court.

Regions which acted in aggression shall be dissolved upon the declaration or act of aggression. All Member regions are to allow travel from this dissolved region into theirs.

Deployment of Military-like forces is the sole responsibility of the Principal Ruler. If the Violation of Human Rights have been done and the Principal Ruler fails to act then this is deemed a violation of Internal Structure Code.

Article 27:

Aggressors are to be captured. No non acting party is to be involved in the dispute to the point where their Human Rights are broken.

Energy to the Aggressing Region is to be cut off and motion into the territory by MV Society Military-like forces will be called to action to escort Humans, not involved, out of the territories.

Humans from these territories are to be processed through Entry Ports and Identity is to be given to them. There they are to reside in a location as the International Development Corps construct homes.

If while they are in residence it becomes known that an individual residing has committed an act against Human Rights then that individual is to be removed and processed through the courts as an anonymous aggressor in a random court.

Article 28:

Following the dissolving and removal of all parties involved in the Human Rights violation all structures must be recorded then destroyed from that region by the International Development Corps.

The new territory is to be processed and investigated thoroughly to locate any individuals who have been stored in locations hidden. These located individuals are to be processed the same as those escaping the territories.

Regional Allocation

Article 29:

The span of territories which has available energy from a unique source which supersede the Base Energy Requirement of the Area shall be known as a unique territory with the provider being named as the Internal Information Regional Advisor for the region.

The International Development Corps in conjunction with the International Regional Advisor shall verify if the newly selected Internal Information Regional Advisor is the Unique Majority source of Energy for the Region. Following this verification the new Region is formed.

Unique Source is a Business which has a singular location. If a Business has multiple locations and receives Energy allocated to Businesses at multiple locations then this is not deemed a unique source despite the Business being a singular entity.

Article 30:

New Regions may now request new structures to be developed within the region by the International Development Corps and can now create an Internal Development Corps.

The New Internal Information Regional Advisor may now be able to focus research within the region to better suit the needs and possible reserves located within it.

Article 31:

Regions without Energy being supplied to them are preservation lands until the point when the Principal Ruler supplies Energy to those regions.

Any Region at any point can be converted to preservation lands if the intent is to preserve the Earth to keep Humanity from having to struggle due to environmental Crises.

Economics

Article 32:

All Regions within the MV Society shall use Energy Units as their method of Value Allocation. All Products and Services are to be equal to the amount of Energy that it took to generate that good or service.

All Humans living within the MV Society shall have access to free available Energy provided by both the Principal Ruler and the Regions Internal Information Regional Advisor to be used to purchase Goods and Services from Businesses by means of carrying that Energy to noted Business.

Businesses are not to have access to this free available Energy for Businesses are not Humans. Businesses receive a set amount of Energy provided to them by the Internal Information Regional Advisor if they deem Businesses in the region require it.

Article 33:

Those who attempt to convert Energy Unit Values into a fiat Currency shall be deemed as an attempt to violate a Human Right to prevent other Humans from exercising their Human Rights by placing a paywall.

Energy shall not be saved in excess unless you are a business. Individuals found to be storing Energy in excess of the total amount given to a region shall be deemed as attempting to violate Human Rights.

Article 34:

Application for Business must be done through the Internal Information Regional Advisor.

Individuals who develop technologies to facilitate the development of Humanity shall have their Identity Annotated in the creation of the Technology and that information is to be transferred to the Internal Information Regional Advisor, then verified by the International Regional Advisor, then recorded by the Co-Rulers.

Amendments and Additions

Article 40:

Amendments and Additions must be approved by the current Principal Ruler and shall not interfere with Human Rights nor the verification structure of the MV Society.

Societies change over time and the Amendments must reflect this change and be noted. No amendment shall have any targeting characteristics.
